

**ORDINANCE NO. 2021-23
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SUBDIVISION CONTROL ORDINANCE, SECTION 8.2 (A, 7, c) OF
HUNTINGTON COUNTY, INDIANA,**

WHEREAS, the Huntington County Plan Commission considered application PC-21-019 filed by the Huntington Countywide Department of Community Development to amend Section 8.2 (A, 7, c) of the Subdivision Control Ordinance, Huntington County, Indiana; and,

WHEREAS, the Huntington County Plan Commission conducted a duly noticed public hearing on application PC-21-019 on May 12, 2021; and,

WHEREAS, the Huntington County Plan Commission, by a 6-0 vote, issued a favorable recommendation to application PC-21-019 at a meeting duly conducted on May 12, 2021. The Huntington County Plan Commission Certification of the favorable recommendation is attached hereto and incorporated by reference as Exhibit "A", and,

WHEREAS, the Huntington County Board of Commissioners now determines that from time to time, it is necessary to amend land use regulations in accordance with IC 36-7-4-607; and,

WHEREAS, such regulations are designed to promote the public health, safety, general welfare, efficiency and economy in the process of the normal and orderly development of the land within the jurisdictional area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF HUNTINGTON COUNTY, INDIANA, that the Huntington County Subdivision Control Ordinance, Section 8.2 (A, 7, c) be amended and to read as follows:
