HUNTINGTON COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 2021-30

AN ORDINANCE PURSUANT TO IC 36-2-2-4 DIVIDING THE COUNTY INTO THREE (3) DISTRICTS THAT ARE COMPOSED OF CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY AND ARE REASONABLY COMPACT

WEAREAS, the Indiana legislature has mandated under the terms of IC 36-2-2-4 et seq. that the County Executive shall divide the county into three (3) districts that are composed of contiguous territory and are reasonably compact; and

WEAREAS, that mandate further provides that the district boundaries drawn by the County Executive must not cross precinct boundary lines and must divide townships only when a division is clearly necessary to accomplish redistricting under said section; and

WEAREAS, the Huntington County Election Board has caused a study to be made in order to conform with the directives of the statute, and has presented several alternatives to the County Executive to accomplish redistricting under IC 36-2-2-4; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Huntington is satisfied that said study is accurate and they are in compliance with the legislation. The Huntington County Commissioners has determined that a division is not required, so this ordinance is recertifying that the districts as drawn comply with the law under IC 36-2-2-4g.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Huntington, that:

- Section 1. The County Board of Commissioners Districts shall be as follows:
- District No. 1: This district shall consist of: Clear Creek, Warren, Jackson, and Dallas Townships.
- District No. 2: This district shall consist of: All of Huntington, Rock Creek, and Union Townships.
- District No. 3: This district shall consist of: Polk, Wayne, Lancaster, Jefferson, and Salamonie Townships.
 - Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
- Section 3. A Copy of this Ordinance with attached map of the district boundaries shall be filed with the Circuit Court Clerk.
