

BPW&S RESOLUTION 2022-7

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY OF THE CITY OF HUNTINGTON, INDIANA TERMINATING THE TEMPORARY EMERGENCY PAID MEDICAL DAY BANK FOR CITY EMPLOYEES ESTABLISHED BY BPW&S RESOLUTION 2021-12

The Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Huntington, Indiana (“Board”), in meeting duly assembled, after considering information deemed by it to be sufficient, finds:

WHEREAS, the Board adopted BPW&S Resolution 2021-12 to establish a temporary emergency paid medical day bank (“Emergency Bank”) for City employees as a way of combating the adverse effects that City employees could suffer by being required to isolate while a COVID diagnosis was being made; and

WHEREAS, since the Emergency Bank’s implementation, 96 City employees have used 447 emergency paid medical days; and

WHEREAS, also since its implementation, COVID testing has become more readily available and COVID vaccinations have been generally available to City employees since December 2020 and it is now appropriate to terminate that Emergency Bank; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by this Board, as follows:

1) The Temporary Emergency Paid Medical Day Bank established by BPW&S Resolution 2021-12 is hereby terminated.

2) The Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to do such things and sign such documents as is necessary to implement this resolution.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED this resolution is effective immediately upon its approval.


