RESCISSION OF ORDINANCE NO. , 2022 - 12


WHEREAS, pursuant to Indiana Code 10-14-3-29 and -29.5, Ordinance No. 12, 2022, declared a local disaster emergency and a local travel advisory warning with mandatory travel restrictions throughout Huntington County; and

WHEREAS, owing to a lessening of the severe weather conditions, Ordinance No. 12, 2022, is therefore appropriate to being rescinded by Ordinance of the Board of Commissioners.


NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the authority vested in us as the Board of Commissioners of Huntington County, Indiana, it is hereby ordered as follows.

Ordinance No. 12, 2022 which declared a local disaster emergency and corresponding local travel warning with restrictions on travel within Huntington County is hereby RESCINDED because the threat to citizens and public-safety personnel caused by the severe-weather conditions has sufficiently abated,


