

Misdemeanor Probation Early Release

To be released from misdemeanor probation early, you may submit a written request through the Probation Department.

You are **ELIGIBLE** if you...

1. Have served at least 60 days on probation or 6 months for first time OWI offense
2. Have not been arrested since being placed on probation.
3. Have completed all your specific terms of probation (Example: community service, counseling, victim impact panel, house arrest, etc.)
4. Have paid all fines and fees in full

You are **NOT ELIGIBLE** if you...

1. Have multiple OWI convictions
2. Have a prior recent felony
3. Have an active warrant
4. Were ordered to daily call-ins
5. Are serving a Domestic Battery sentence
6. Have any new criminal offenses or criminal charges
7. Had a Petition to Revoke filed under this cause number

Early release from Probation is not a right and must be approved by the Court. Contact your probation officer if you believe you qualify to be released from probation early.
