

Synopsis: This Ordinance, if adopted, would amend Section 75.04(A) of the City of Huntington, Indiana's Code of Ordinances concerning bicycle riding on City sidewalks.

ORDINANCE 11-C-23

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF HUNTINGTON, INDIANA BY AMENDING SECTION 75.04(A)

The Common Council ("Council") of the City of Huntington, Indiana ("City") in meeting duly assembled and upon information deemed by it to be sufficient, finds as follows:

WHEREAS, the current prohibition of bicycle riding on sidewalks in business districts covers too much area and should be amended and reduced to only the downtown area of the City; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by Council that Section 75.04(A) is hereby repealed and replaced in its entirety as follows:

“§ 75.04 RIDING ON SIDEWALKS.

(A) No person shall ride a bicycle on a sidewalk located within the downtown area being that area between the eastern boundary of Warren Street, the western boundary of Cherry Street, the northern boundary of East and West Park Drive, and the southern boundary of Court and State Streets.”

BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED THAT, this ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its adoption and all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed.
