

ORDINANCE 12-C-23

Synopsis: This ordinance, if adopted, would provide additional funding to ARPA Fund: street paving program and Police Dash cam and Motorola Radios 2402-001-900; LRS Fund: street paving 220-018-434; MVH Fund: street paving 2201-019-232; MVH Restricted: street paving 2203-01-232; General Fund: street paving 1101-011-440.

ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE
