IN THE MATTER OF MINUTES)

Capital Investment Grant

Leslie Rentschler, Community Corrections Director spoke with the Commissioners about a Capital Investment Grant that she received some information on. She is unsure of the specifics of the grant at this time, but will keep the Commissioners updated on the scope as she receives more information.

Andrews Police Department

Town Marshal Austin Bullock from the Andrews Police Department spoke with the Commissioners about the need to update their body cameras. The Commissioners asked if he had researched any grant opportunities that may be available – EMA Director Bob Jeffers would be a good contact for this. They also asked him to consult with the Andrews Town Council to see what funding they can provide. The Commissioners are very much in favor of the new body cameras and would be happy to partner with the other entities involved to get them purchased.

IN THE MATTER OF DISCUSSION)

Communications

Kevin Krauskopf, Communications Coordinator spoke with the Commissioners regarding the expectations for his position from the County. Kevin is working on the County website and was recently given access to the Commissioners' Facebook page in order to improve communication with the public. Commissioner Stoffel would like for Kevin to attend the bi-weekly meetings and Commissioner Wall stated that he would like a monthly update.

IN THE MATTER OF DISCUSSION)

Duress Alarms

Joakim Abrahamsson, IT Director gave an update on the Duress Alarms. The alarms were on back-order, but they have been delivered. The IT Department is doing the set up for them and will get them dispersed as soon as possible.

Joakim also talked to the Commissioners regarding the audio equipment upgrade for the GAR Room. He stated that it would be \$3,600.00 for the equipment and \$2,500.00 for the installation.

Joakim stated that the printer for the Extension Office would be added to the county lease effective January 1, 2024.

Norwood Water Meters

The Commissioners discussed the replacement water meters for the Norwood Regional Water and Sewer District. The installation quote came in \$18,626.00 over the initial request. Laura Dillon attended via Zoom and stated that she would talk to the board about utilizing \$14,000.00 from the sanitation fund. The Commissioners stated that they would work with them to make up the overage.

O'Donnell Center Update

Phil Hibbert, Facilities Manager spoke with the Commissioners to see if the were any updates as to when the Stations of the Cross may be moved to St. Felix. There has been no update at this time. Phil stated that the leak in the roof near the EMA offices has been resolved.
