## BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY OF THE CITY OF HUNTINGTON, INDIANA

The Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Huntington, Indiana ("Board"), in meeting duly assembled and after considering information deemed by it to be sufficient, finds:

WHEREAS, with the completion of new homes on Arbor Lane in the Salamonie Glenn Subdivision, the speed limit should be changed to 25 MPH for the safety of the public and to match the speed limits of other City subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with City Code Section 78.10, based on the Police Chief's recommendation and information provided by the City Engineering and Street Departments, the Board determines that the speed limit along Arbor Lane should be lowered to provide safety to the public and consistency with similar areas; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by this Board as follows:

- 1) The Board hereby establishes a 25 MPH speed limit on Arbor Lane, as described in the attached and incorporated Exhibit A.
- 2) The City Services Department, in conjunction with the City's Police Department, and Engineering Department, shall erect appropriate signage as soon as possible and existing signage is hereby approved.
- 3) In accordance with City Code Section 70.03, the City Police Department is authorized to enforce this regulation.
- 4) This speed limit shall remain in effect subject to further action by the Common Council.
