Become a Homeowner: Habitat for Humanity Applications Open in Huntington County April 7 — April 28, 2025

FORT WAYNE, IN (Tuesday, March 25) – Habitat for Humanity of Greater Fort Wayne is opening the application process for its homeownership program in Huntington County. Families living or working in Huntington County can apply starting **Monday, April 7, through Sunday, April 28, 2025**.

Interested applicants must first complete a **pre-qualification form** on Habitat's website (<u>habitatgfw.com/apply</u>). Those who prequalify will be notified via email to continue with a full application packet.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must currently live or work in Huntington County for at least 12 months as of April 7, 2025.
- Must not be a current homeowner or have owned a home in the past two years.
- Must have a minimum annual income of \$30,000.
